

# Holiday Horse Wreath

## Supplies

- Thick wire (a coat hanger or floral wire will work)
- 2-3 strands of garland
- Hot glue gun
- Twine, thin wire, fishing line, or something similar (to create inner framework)
- Thin wire, fishing line, thread, or something similar (to attach garland)
- Holiday trimmings (ribbon, bows, ornaments, etc.)
- Scissors
- Pliers with wire cutters (only needed if using thick wire or garland with a wire base)
- Mat or newspaper to cover workspace



# Holiday Horse Wreath

## Instructions

1. Cover workspace with the mat or newspaper and gather your supplies!
2. Twist the thick wire together to form a loop and bend into the shape of a horse's head.
3. Weave the twine, thin wire, or fishing line across the outer framework to create an inner framework to attach the garland to.
4. Attach the garland using hot glue, thin wire, fishing line, thread, or the garland itself to the framework. Begin on the outer framework to create the silhouette and then spiral in until the entire wreath is filled in.
5. Put the finishing touches on your wreath by attaching your favorite holiday trimmings with hot glue! You can use the ribbon to create a halter or bridle for your horse.
6. Hang your wreath and enjoy the finished product!
